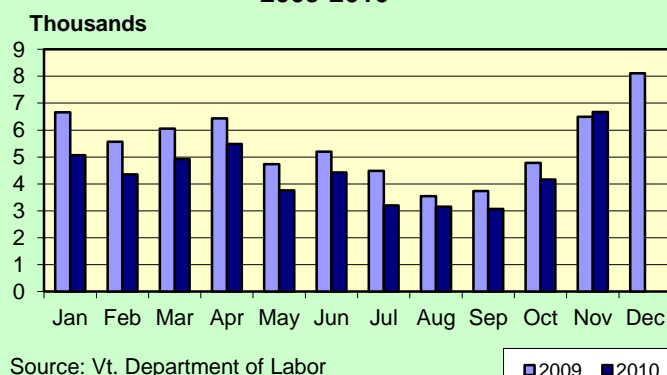

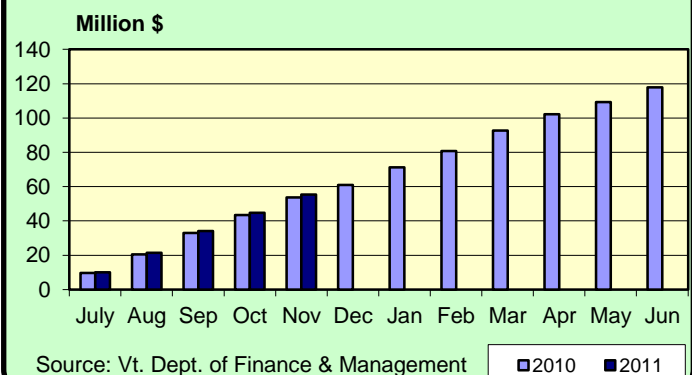

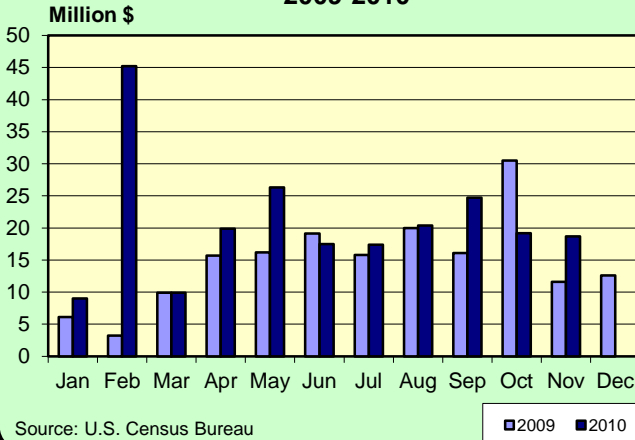

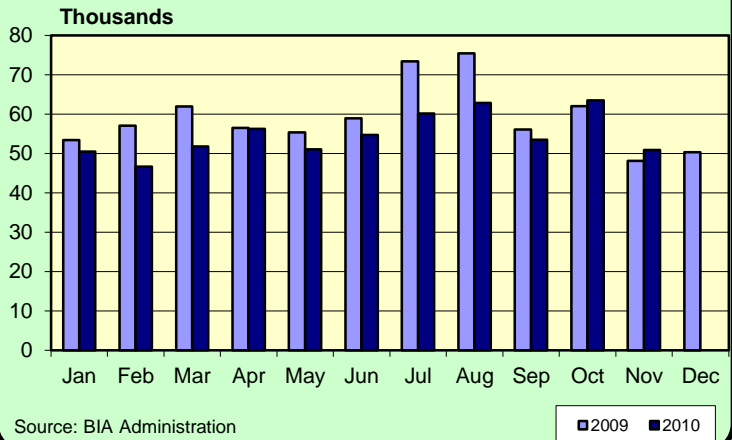

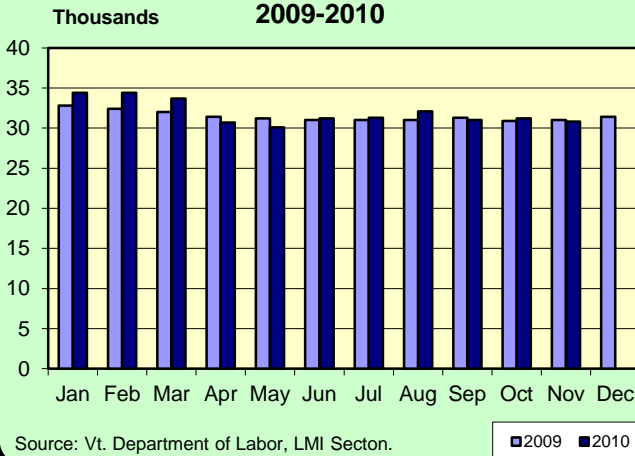
**Vermont Residential Building Permits

2009-2010**



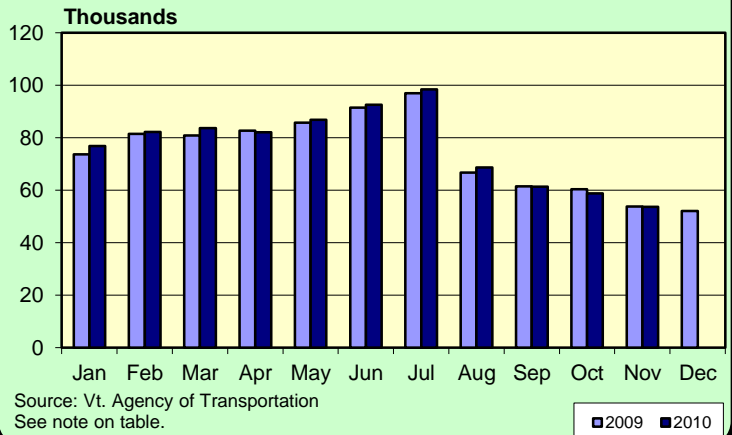
**Enplanements 2009-2010
Burlington International Airport**



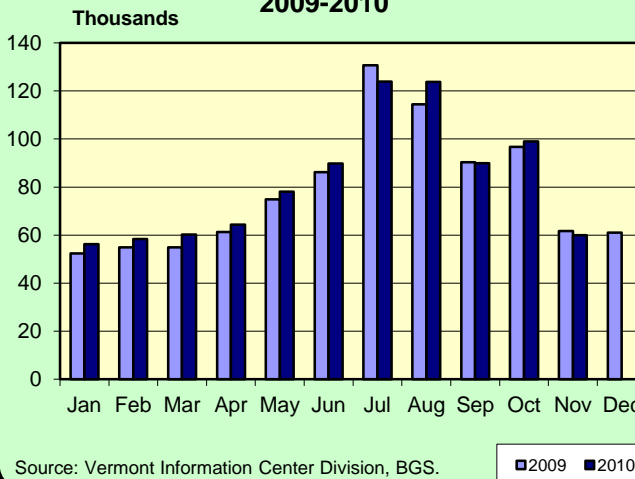
**Leisure & Hospitality Employment

2009-2010**



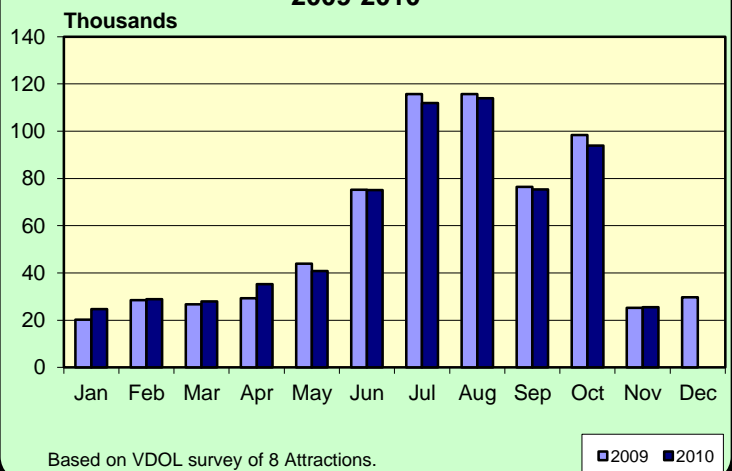
**Traffic Volumes at Selected Locations
